Fullmer Chapman Scholarship Criteria

The Inland Empire / Desert Chapter of the Maintenance Superintendents Association (MSA) Fullmer Chapman Scholarship Fund grants annual scholarships for education, training and development in the general field of *Public Administration or a related course of study, e.g., engineering, maintenance, landscape design, horticulture, etc.* The Chapter's Board of Directors acts as the selection committee by reviewing applications, interviewing candidates, and awarding scholarships to persons, meeting all of the criteria defined below. Applications shall be submitted on the **MSA Fullmer Chapman Scholarship Application Form** and are due on or before **April 30th**. Late or incomplete applications shall not be considered. Those individuals selected to receive a scholarship will be advised in late May and will receive the award at the Chapter's June general meeting.

High School or College Student Criteria

To qualify applicant must:

- Be a high school graduate, or a senior in high school and maintained a minimum 2.5 GPA during the last two years in high school.
- Be a full time college student (12 units) attending a junior college, a technical trade school, or a four-year university and enrolled in a coursework described above in italics; or, if a senior in high school be accepted to a junior college, a technical trade school, or a four-year university and planning to major in the field of study described above in italics.
- Be a legal resident
- Submit official high school or college transcripts for review and verification.
- Submit a letter of endorsement from a current Inland Empire / Desert Chapter MSA member
- **Submit a personal statement describing your background, interests, accomplishments and goals. Please include any honors / awards you have received. Explain why you should be considered for the MSA Fullmer Chapman Scholarship.**

General Services Employee Criteria/

To qualify applicant must:

- Be working full-time in a related field.
- Be currently attending or accepted to a junior college, a technical trade school, or a four-year university and enrolled in subjects related to the coursework described above in italics, as a part-time student carrying 3 or more units.
- Be a legal resident.
- Submit official college transcripts for review and verification.
- Submit a letter of endorsement from a current Inland Empire / Desert Chapter MSA member.
- **Submit a personal statement describing your background, interests, accomplishments and goals. Please include any honors / awards you have received. Explain why you should be considered for the MSA Fullmer Chapman Scholarship.**
